

So sensitive, shy Jayni gradually becomes brave, grownup and glamorous `Lola Rose'. But things don't go as smoothly as planned. Lola Rose's mum goes into hospital and Lola rose has to be more grown up than she had ever anticipated. Although a bit depressing and bleak at times, this is still one of the best books I've read in a very long time. It will make you laugh and cry, and take you to a place you've never been before.
