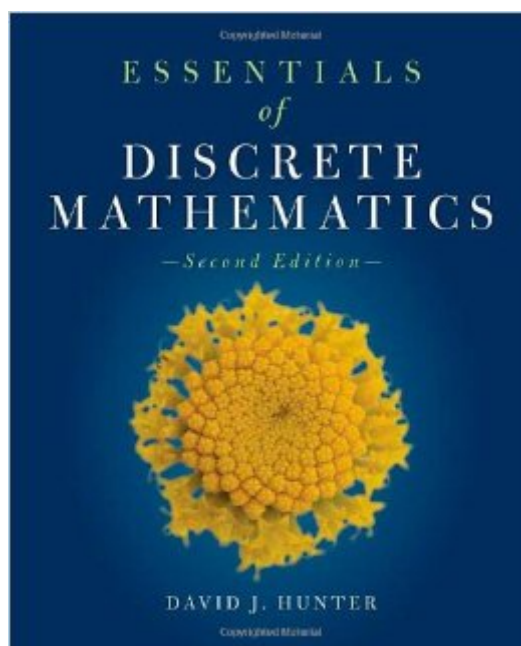

This book is written and illustrated in a manner that is clear and precise, while using plain English. Terminology is explained. Intermediate steps are explained. Dependencies between chapters and sections are clearly marked. Exercises and examples are relevant and progress from simple to complex. A good breadth of subject matter is covered. For the reader who is not particularly

mathematically-inclined, but who needs to master the fundamentals of discrete mathematics, (such as for computer science), this is an outstanding book, head and shoulders above any other I've used (and, to get a grip on discrete math, algorithms, and optimization, I've been reading A LOT of them lately).

I used this book for two logic courses. The book is laid out in a straightforward logical (I would expect as much from such a book) fashion. You should be able to go from the first to the last chapter without a need to jump around to connect concepts as they simply build upon one another. Each chapter is also self contained meaning that if you only wanted to learn about graph theory you could skip to that section and read it and be able to understand it without needing to consult other chapters which is nice when you take a semester break between logic courses. The best part are the problem sections which the book provides detailed answers for. Unlike most math books which only detail a few steps or simply give you an answer to reference this book will actually lead you through the process of solving the problems which is immensely helpful.
