The high-quality pictures and age-appropriate articles are hard to resist. Everything about this book grabs your attention! My 8 year old and I read some of the articles together. This is another edition of a wonderful book for kids. We have been buying them every year for awhile now because the kids love curling up with the almanac and flipping through the beautiful pages.
