I recently purchased this book for my 6 year old son. The bank just got robbed by 3 crooks and it is up to the police to find them and save the day. My son really enjoyed this book. Some of the illustrations go along with some of the lego kits he has. Easy, understandable text and great illustrations. A must own for the lego lover that is beginning to read.

My son who is winding up his Kinder year (homeschool) must read a new book aloud everyday. I'm always looking for high-interest books while trying to keep it age/level appropriate. I'll admit, I purchased this solely for the interest (he loves Legos), but secretly wished this title (or similar) was offered at a Level 3. He tends to get excited over books, but I have never seen him light up the way he did when this came out of the box! The first thing I noticed was that it did not offer very many words per page (fitting for a level 1), but I was pleased to see several challenging words in the short sentences. A few good challenger words are: sirens, video, questions, officer. Bottom line: he LOVED

the story, and illustrations, and he also loved watching his Lego sets come to life. I have purchased several Lego themed readers, and we have been pleased with all of them. I highly recommend these high-interest readers for any Lego fan!

Again, another good Lego reader for the K-2nd grade crowd. My 3 and 6 year old grand sons love the Lego City series of books. Definitely helps the reading learning process. Highly recommend this to your reader list. This has not been a challenge for 6 year old home schooled grandson. Very easy to read by himself and to his 3 year old brother.
